FIRST — HERE'S WHY

Jobs

Young workers and students are having trouble finding good jobs with benefits and job security. Many of the jobs available are short-term, contract, and precarious—making it hard to pay off student loans or get out of your parents' basement.

Child Care

The cost of child care amounts to a second mortgage for many young families, if they can even find a space. We need a plan that ensures safe, affordable, available child care for every child.

Education

As the cost of going to school skyrockets, and student debt rises, accessing quality post-secondary education falls further out of reach for many young Canadians.

Climate

The economy and the environment go hand in hand. Climate change is a reality, and a just transition to a greener economy is necessary for our well-being and that of future generations.

Public transit & infrastructure

Building greener cities can be tied to job creation for young people. Having sustainable transportation systems is good for communities.

Healthy democracy

The new Elections Act has made it harder for many young people and students to vote. We need a system that encourages young people to exercise their voices. When youth vote, we create change on issues important to us.

HERE'S HOW

- 1. Make sure you are registered.**
- 2. Know where to vote.**
- 3. Check that you have the right IDENTIFICATION.**

GET REGISTERED!

It's simple. Just visit elections.ca.

You can also register on the spot when you go to vote, but **bring the right ID**.

WHERE TO VOTE

- VOTE at any Elections Canada office**

- VOTE at your ADVANCE POLL,**

October 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th (from noon until 8 pm)

- VOTE ON ELECTION DAY, OCTOBER 19TH**

THE RIGHT IDENTIFICATION

- Show one piece of government-issued ID,** which must include a NAME, PHOTO, and your CURRENT ADDRESS (e.g., a driver's license, provincial or territorial ID card);

OR

- Show two pieces of ID,** one piece with your NAME and another with your NAME and ADDRESS (e.g., health card and phone bill, or debit card and bank statement);

OR

- Take an oath,** show two pieces of ID with your name, and have someone who knows you attest to your address (*this person must show proof of identity and address and be registered in the same polling division*);

OR

- Provide a letter** of confirmation of residence, letter of stay, admission form, or statement of benefits from one of the designated establishments: student residence, senior residence, shelter, or soup kitchen.
